iPrism 8.102 is primarily a bug fix release which incorporates hot-fixes for the 8.100 release as well as consolidates software support for the G-Series, H-Series and the newly introduced WSA Series appliances.

Applicable Appliances

WSA-Series appliances: WSA7550, WSA7750, WSA7850

G-Series appliances: 35G, 75G, 150G, 500G, 1000G, 1000GR2

H-Series appliances: 25H, 35H, 55H, 105H, 500H

During the upgrade process, any scheduled report output that was configured to be “Stored on iPrism” will be lost. Users should download and save that report output prior to upgrading. Scheduled reports that run after the upgrade will be stored on the iPrism as usual.

Please note:

* While the 25H appliances are supported, due to resource limitations on these older models the performance will be impacted so it is recommended that you upgrade to the 35G.
